Walk-in for lunch or dinner. Great spot on the Ile St. Louis. Take a window table if one is available for views of the Ile de la Cite – including the back of Notre Dame. Good French onion soup, and a dish called Ravioles de Royan – tiny leek and cheese filled raviolis in a chive and cream sauce. Bertillon ice cream served both in the café and also at a take-away window outside. Good breakfast spot as well, and the omelettes are available all day.
